How to pray when life is too much. V1-2 Bring your pain, suffering and heartache to God, He is able to handle all of what you are going through. V3-11 is the psalmist's specific plea that He has to God, our prayers may start like v 1-2 and then tell God what is on your mind, what you are going through, how you feel and what you desire.
