<p>Justice: Psalm 33:5;Deuteronomy 32:4;Romans 2:8</p> <p>Humility:James 4:6;10 Psalm 51:7;Matthew 5:3</p> <p>I need salvation vs I deserve salvation.</p> <p>Righteous Path: Psalm 34:19;Matthew 5:6</p> <p>Godless belittles, speaks to destroy destroys neighbor: 1 Peter 3:16(opposite); Mark 12:31</p> <p>Guidance/Correction: Hosea 4:6; John 16:13; 2 Timothy 2:25;Matthew 11:29</p> <p>Kindness: Ephesian 4:32; Galatians 6:10;Proverbs 21:21;Matthew 5:7</p>	<p>[1] A false balance is an abomination to the LORD, but a just weight is his delight.</p> <p>[2] When pride comes, then comes disgrace, but with the humble is wisdom.</p> <p>[3] The integrity of the upright guides them, but the crookedness of the treacherous destroys them.</p> <p>[4] Riches do not profit in the day of wrath, but righteousness delivers from death.</p> <p>[5] The righteousness of the blameless keeps his way straight, but the wicked falls by his own wickedness.</p> <p>[6] The righteousness of the upright delivers them, but the treacherous are taken captive by their lust.</p> <p>[7] When the wicked dies, his hope will perish, and the expectation of wealth perishes too.</p> <p>[8] The righteous is delivered from trouble, and the wicked walks into it instead.</p> <p>[9] With his mouth the godless man would destroy his neighbor, but by knowledge the righteous are delivered.</p> <p>[10] When it goes well with the righteous, the city rejoices, and when the wicked perish there are shouts of gladness.</p> <p>[11] By the blessing of the upright a city is exalted, but by the mouth of the wicked it is overthrown.</p> <p>[12] Whoever belittles his neighbor lacks sense, but a man of understanding remains silent.</p> <p>[13] Whoever goes about slandering reveals secrets, but he who is trustworthy in spirit keeps a thing covered.</p> <p>[14] Where there is no guidance, a people falls, but in an abundance of counselors there is safety.</p> <p>[15] Whoever puts up security for a stranger will surely suffer harm, but he who hates striking hands in pledge is secure.</p> <p>[16] A gracious woman gets honor, and violent men get riches.</p> <p>[17] A man who is kind benefits himself, but a cruel man hurts himself.</p> <p>[18] The wicked earns deceptive wages, but one who sows righteousness gets a sure reward.</p>

<p>Character is important to God 1 Timothy 3:2; Psalm 23:3-4; Galatians 5:22-23</p> <p>God has a sense of humor→</p> <p>Giving to others: Proverbs 19:17; Psalm 82:3; Proverbs 14:21.</p> <p>Seeking Good: Amos 5:14;</p>	<p>[19] Whoever is steadfast in righteousness will live, but he who pursues evil will die.</p> <p>[20] Those of crooked heart are an abomination to the LORD, but those of blameless ways are his delight.</p> <p>[21] Be assured, an evil person will not go unpunished, but the offspring of the righteous will be delivered.</p> <p>[22] Like a gold ring in a pig's snout is a beautiful woman without discretion.</p> <p>[23] The desire of the righteous ends only in good, the expectation of the wicked in wrath.</p> <p>[24] One gives freely, yet grows all the richer; another withholds what he should give, and only suffers want.</p> <p>[25] Whoever brings blessing will be enriched, and one who waters will himself be watered.</p> <p>[26] The people curse him who holds back grain, but a blessing is on the head of him who sells it.</p> <p>[27] Whoever diligently seeks good seeks favor, but evil comes to him who searches for it.</p> <p>[28] Whoever trusts in his riches will fall, but the righteous will flourish like a green leaf.</p> <p>[29] Whoever troubles his own household will inherit the wind, and the fool will be servant to the wise of heart.</p> <p>[30] The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and whoever captures souls is wise.</p> <p>[31] If the righteous is repaid on earth, how much more the wicked and the sinner! (ESV)</p>
