| <p>V1-7 How long will the wicked celebrate?</p> <p>Romans 15: 1-6</p> <p>“The Proud” why is pride dangerous what other scriptures increase our knowledge of pride?</p> <p>V8-15 When will these fools become wise?</p> <p>This is a display of compassion, the psalmist wants them to turn from wickedness and foolishness.</p> <p>V 16-23 can a corrupt king ally with God.</p> <p>Numbers 32:16-23 Isaiah 10:1-4</p> <p>Romans 12:19 Revelation 6:9-11</p> | <p>[1] O LORD, God of vengeance, O God of vengeance, shine forth!</p> <p>[2] Rise up, O judge of the earth; repay to the proud what they deserve!</p> <p>[3] O LORD, how long shall the wicked, how long shall the wicked exult?</p> <p>[4] They pour out their arrogant words; all the evildoers boast.</p> <p>[5] They crush your people, O LORD, and afflict your heritage.</p> <p>[6] They kill the widow and the sojourner, and murder the fatherless;</p> <p>[7] and they say, “The LORD does not see, the God of Jacob does not perceive.”</p> <p>[8] Understand, O dumbest of the people! Fools, when will you be wise?</p> <p>[9] He who planted the ear, does he not hear? He who formed the eye, does he not see?</p> <p>[10] He who disciplines the nations, does he not rebuke? He who teaches man knowledge—</p> <p>[11] the LORD—knows the thoughts of man, that they are but a breath.</p> <p>[12] Blessed is the man whom you discipline, O LORD, and whom you teach out of your law,</p> <p>[13] to give him rest from days of trouble, until a pit is dug for the wicked.</p> <p>[14] For the LORD will not forsake his people; he will not abandon his heritage;</p> <p>[15] for justice will return to the righteous, and all the upright in heart will follow it.</p> <p>[16] Who rises up for me against the wicked? Who stands up for me against evildoers?</p> <p>[17] If the LORD had not been my help, my soul would soon have lived in the land of silence.</p> <p>[18] When I thought, “My foot slips,” your steadfast love, O LORD, held me up.</p> <p>[19] When the cares of my heart are many, your consolations cheer my soul.</p> <p>[20] Can wicked rulers be allied with you, those who frame injustice by statute?</p> <p>[21] They band together against the life of the righteous and condemn the innocent to death.</p> | |

| <p>V1-2 Come Worship</p> <p>V3-7 Reasons to Worship</p> <p>V 7-11 A Warning</p> <p>Why is worshipping God so important? Without the sacrifice of Christ, we would be on the outside unable to worship God, that barrier was destroyed by Christ, which is why it is important to remember Him on the first day of the week. Christ made it all possible.</p> <p>Why worship? God is Great, He made creation, We are His people. He has redeemed us.</p> <p>V 8-11 you can not have an unbelieving heart and worship God.</p> <p>Hebrews 3:7 ; 4:1;11-13</p> | <p>[1] Oh come, let us sing to the LORD; let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation!</p> <p>[2] Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise!</p> <p>[3] For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods.</p> <p>[4] In his hand are the depths of the earth; the heights of the mountains are his also.</p> <p>[5] The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land.</p> <p>[6] Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the LORD, our Maker!</p> <p>[7] For he is our God, and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand. Today, if you hear his voice,</p> <p>[8] do not harden your hearts, as at Meribah, as on the day at Massah in the wilderness,</p> <p>[9] when your fathers put me to the test and put me to the proof, though they had seen my work.</p> <p>[10] For forty years I loathed that generation and said, "They are a people who go astray in their heart, and they have not known my ways."</p> <p>[11] Therefore I swore in my wrath, "They shall not enter my rest."
