David uses the word MY several times to indicate what God is to him.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Verse 3 David calls upon the Lord.. states He is worthy of praise!(Worship)</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Verses 5-7 David prayed when everything seemed bad, but how bad?</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Verses 8-16 God's Power is described</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Verses 17-19 God Rescues David</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Verse 20-24 David says "Why" he believes God saved HIm? Does this ALWAYS work out this way? If you live wickedly are you likely to suffer for your actions? Do we always see the wicked suffer?</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Verses 25-29 God delivered because David is faithful!
