"This is the first of fifteen Songs of Ascents (Psalms 120-134). They were evidently songs used by pilgrims on their way up to the Temple at Jerusalem for the feasts. The present psalm seems sharply personal, although in a pilgrim context it voices very well the homesickness of those who have settled among strangers and enemies. It appears that this man was surrounded by a lying neighbor. "The prayer reminds us what the world we live in is like. It is	[1] In my distress I called to the LORD, and he answered me.
